

FIRST AID TRAINING FOR EARLY YEARS & SCHOOLS

DANGER Is it safe?

RESPONSE Talk to them, tap them on the shoulder.

SHOUT FOR HELP Is a defibrillator available?

AIRWAY Open the airway as shown.

BREATHING Is it normal or abnormal? (check for no more than 10 seconds)

START BASIC LIFE SUPPORT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE



5 BREATHS



30 CHEST COMPRESSIONS

1/3 of chest depth 100-120 per minute



2 BREATHS over 1sec each

REPEAT 2 & 3
